



Basic Hygiene Kits for Immigrants



Trinity on the Border is collecting basic hygiene kits for those just arriving in the United States.

Who gets them?

These kits will go to our partners who are working with immigrants, including:

- **The Humanitarian Respite Center** (HRC) in McAllen, TX provides basic services like showers, new clothes, food, and information to people who are applying for asylum in the United States. The HRC welcomes between 80 and 200 refugees and immigrants each day.
- **La Posada Providencia** in San Benito, TX is an emergency shelter for immigrants and asylum seekers. Clients are provided with food and shelter as well as citizenship training as they wait for their legal immigration processes to be resolved.

What do I do?

STEP 1: Decide how many kits you will assemble and purchase the following items for each kit:

- A bar of soap (soap is preferred to detergent bars)
- A clean, new washcloth
- A toothbrush
- A small tube of toothpaste
- 2-3 Band-Aids

STEP 2: Put all of these items into a clean, new quart-size Ziploc bags.

STEP 3: Load the completed bags into a box and mail to:
